

General Information for the Duver Dash charity fun run event at Bembridge Harbour

DIRECTIONS BY ROAD: Duver Marina, Bembridge Harbour, The Duver, St Helens, IoW PO33 1YB

From the west you go through the village of St Helens on Upper Green Road - past St Helens Green on your right. The road becomes Eddington Road and as it bends to the left there's a right turn into Duver Road. From the direction of Ryde Eddington Road takes you past Nodes Point Holiday Park (on the left) – at the bottom of the hill turn sharp left into Duver Road.

At the bottom of the hill follow the road round to the right, across The Duver. Parking is in the National Trust Car Park (PO33 1XY) on the left - their standard charges apply (see below). Please **DO NOT PARK** on the Duver or on the grass. Alternative parking can be found adjacent to St Helens Beach (Council charges apply). Blue Badge parking can be made available - please get in touch in advance: gordon@bembridgeharbour.co.uk

National Trust Car Parking charges (NT members free): £2 up to 1 hour, £4.00 for 1-4 hours, £8 for 4 hours

PARKING: there is a National Trust Car Park (PO33 1XY) on the left as you drive across the Duver - their standard charges apply. Please **DO NOT PARK** on the Duver or on the grass. Alternative parking can be found adjacent to St Helens Beach (Council charges apply). Blue Badge parking can be made available - please get in touch in advance: mail@bembridgeharbour.co.uk

WATER TAXI: the Harbour water taxi service operates from the main Duver Marina pontoon, and picks up at Bembridge Point Beach, Bembridge Marina and Fishermans Pontoon. Maximum of 9 passengers but Covid-19 safety measures may limit numbers. Fares (single): 15 years and over £2, 14 and under £1, infants free of charge.

REFRESHMENTS: The Duver Cafe at the Duver Marina serves a range of fresh coffee, teas and soft drinks, cakes as well as freshly made breakfast rolls, and sandwiches. There's no indoor seating but plenty of outside seating to enable safe social distancing, with views right across the Harbour, and a large marquee is available for shelter if needed. Open daily from 0830.

TOILETS: Toilet (only) facilities are available, currently accessed via a one-way system, with face coverings required in the communal areas. They are an inclusive mixture of combined toilet and shower cubicles as well as separate toilet and shower units. Please do not use the showers at the current time. Disabled facilities are available on request.

Please use the hand sanitiser provided and respect others by keeping a safe social distance and waiting outside if the facilities are busy.

COVID-19: all Harbour sites are fully Risk Assessed and a number of safety measures are in place including one-way systems, hand washing and sanitiser stations, and the wearing of face coverings in areas where social distancing isn't possible.

DRINKING WATER: due to Covid safety measures a water station cannot not be provided, but a complimentary bottle of water will be waiting for you when you collect your medal. We're sorry about the one-use plastic but will have a recycling bin nearby for appropriate disposal.

DOGS: we welcome responsible owners who keep their dogs on a lead and under control whilst on Harbour property. Dogs are not allowed in the toilets but "parking" facilities are provided for them outside. There is a wash-off area at the top of the slipway for getting rid of mud and sand off paws. There is dog waste bin just outside the marina entrance.
